***THE INDIAN ARTS AND CRAFTS ACT OF 1990**

The Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990 (P.L. 101-644) is a truth-in-advertising law that prohibits misrepresentation in marketing of Indian arts and crafts products within the United States. It is illegal to offer or display for sale, or sell any art or craft product in a manner that falsely suggests it is Indian produced, an Indian product, or the product of a particular Indian or Indian tribe or Indian arts and crafts organization, resident within the United States.

By participating in the NMAI Native American Art Market, you warrant and represent that you have complied with the Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990, as well as all other applicable laws and regulations pertaining to the sale of your products.

ACCEPTANCE: *Vendors who are selected* for the NMAI Art Market will be notified on or before October 1, 2008. Upon acceptance, vendor will secure a market table with a registration fee of \$175 (money orders only) . Liability insurance will be provided through the Smithsonian Institution.

Vendors who are not selected will be notified by mail in October.
